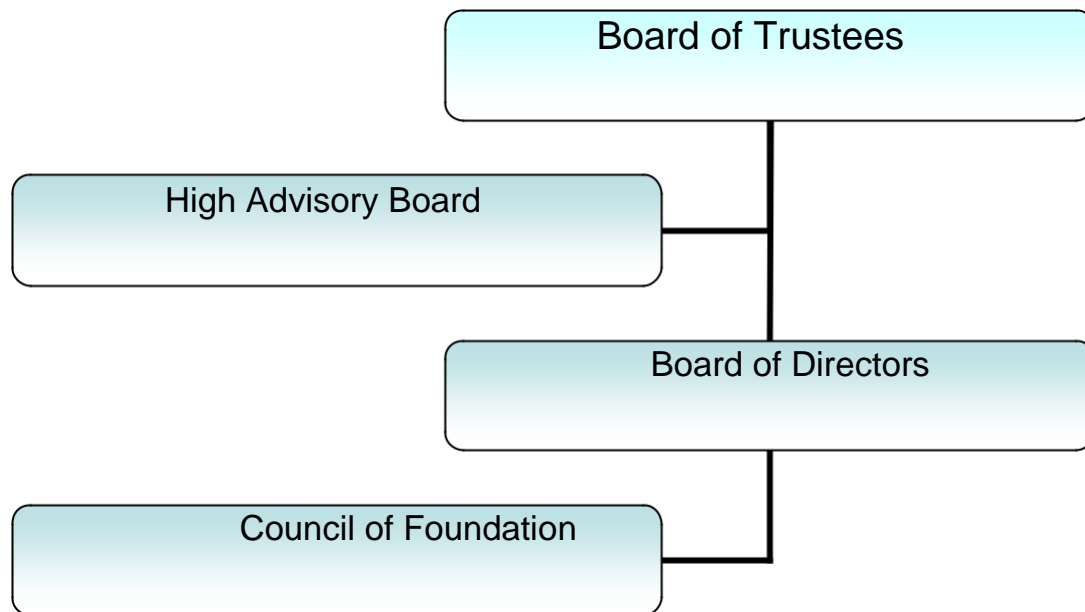

## 1. Abstract

### **Abstract of Activities:**

Our foundation carried out 8 activities related to its founding purpose during 2003.

3 of these activities carried out as seminar, exam organization and production of publishing within the scope of educational projects. Scholarship were among our important works in 2003 as well.

Teachers' Day celebrations traditionally carried out by our foundation were also held in 2003.

Our foundation continued the struggle against harmful substance habits from our society and carried out a panel organization that brought this issue to the agenda.

Our foundation provided 17.750.000.000 TL scholarship in 2003. Also, our foundation provided support to those who do not have a financial possibility with welfare activities such as food, clothes and firing.

Our foundation carried out 20 management meetings: 6 board of trustees, 14 board of directors within the context of management activities during 2003.

Anatolia Education and Culture Foundation brought Turkey's first Foundation Vocational School of Higher Education to the country's higher education. Anadolu Bil Vocational School of Higher Education which had permission to start education in 12 associate degree programs was located in Bahçelievler Campus.

Anadolu Bil Vocational School of Higher Education established on 26.09.2003 for training facilities on the purpose of raising high-graded intermediate workforce needed by private corporations and government agencies in the fields of economy and industry, providing an opportunity of associate degree education to graduates of vocational-technical education and other secondary education institutions, contribute to the formation of trained human resources of our country by incorporate institutions with the technical equipment and background at the desired level into AKEV and raising youth who are in the light of Atatürkist thought, secular, modern, researcher, innovator; who have full knowledge of the subjects of basic culture and technology, reached to world culture and who will strengthen themselves and provide employment opportunity.

Our foundation provided growth every passing year in the number of institutions in cooperation and communication with. It had an effective and coherent year with the local administrations, educational institutions, central educational organizations, civil society organizations and private sector institutions that are business solution partners.
